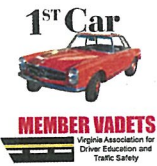

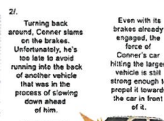

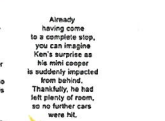
Collision Involvement
